Notes:

Spitfire shows **Middle C** as C4. Ableton works with C3. Therefore you have to select, for example, C-2 in the Keyswitch & Expression Map for the keyswitch C-1 in the player!

A rather hidden but great feature is the possibility to set the **bowing pattern** for short techniques. This allows you to bring even more realism to your compositions! Unfortunately without the possibility to change it dynamically outside the player with MIDI CCs. Maybe in a future update?
